Collection Districts for City Residents

Day

District #1 – Shall consist of all territory East of Wyoming Street and South of Broad Street including and Hazleton Heights.

Monday

District #2 – Shall consist of all territory West of Wyoming Street and South of Diamond Avenue Including Birch Knoll Estates and Laurel Hill Terrace.

Tuesday

District #3 – Shall consist of all territory East of Wyoming Street and between Broad Street and Diamond Avenue and East of Carson Street and North of Diamond Avenue.

Wednesday

District #4 – Shall consist of all territory North of Diamond Avenue between Carson and Locust Streets.

Thursday

District #5 – Shall consist of all territory North of Diamond Avenue and West of Locust Street.

You Can Make a Difference

These items can be commingled in any recycling bin:

Cans

Aluminum beverage cans and steel and tin food cans. Please rinse the can and remove the lid or push it into the can. No need to remove labels.

NO FOIL OR FOOD TRAYS, PLEASE!

Glass

Food and beverage containers such as jars and bottles only! Clear, green or brown glass. Remove lids and rinse. Leave labels on. No light bulbs, mirrors, window glass, etc. Cans and glass may be mixed together in the same recycling container.

Plastics

#1 and #2 food and beverage and detergent containers only. The number is on the bottom of the bottle. Most soda, milk, and water bottles fit this category.

Paper should be Separate Container

Newspapers, magazines, office paper, and phone books less than an inch and a half thick must be tied in bundles or bagged with paper grocery bags and placed at the curb.

Holidays

If your collection day falls on a holiday it will be one day late. Trash and recycling collection will resume on the next day. **Holidays:** New Year's Day (January 1), Memorial Day, Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day (December 25).

Rules About Trash Collection for Hazleton

Trash & Recycling: Trash & recycling are collected once a week; your collection day stays the same.



Bulk Waste: Includes furniture, mattresses, large carpets, major appliances, etc; Picked up on regular collection day; limit one bulk item per week; major appliances by appointment, call us at **1-800-243-7575**, freon must be removed first and have a sticker.

Major Appliances: major appliances will be collected by appointment only, call us at **1-800-243-7575**



Yard Waste: Place yard waste in container or biodegradable paper bags. There will be city wide yard waste curbside collection on a designated day in April and in November every year, a more specific day will be advertised in the local newspaper before collection occurs. Items that can be set out include grass, leaves, hedge trimmings & brush (must be tied & in 4 foot lengths).

Yard waste will only be collected in the City as indicated above. It will not be collected on your regular collection day. Do not place yard waste curbside.

There will be a drop off site for yard waste at the City Public Works building located at [25 North Cedar Street beginning March 1, 2008](#). Residents can bring their yard waste here Monday thru Friday between hours of 7am & 3pm.

Trash Containers: For trash use 32 gallon plastic containers with tight fitting lids or heavy duty plastic bags tied off at the top. **KEEP HAZLETON LITTER FREE!**

Please No Home Construction or Demolition Debris!

If you're putting on a new roof or remodeling your house, you need to make special arrangements with us or another waste hauler to remove the debris. Call the number below for more information.



No Hazardous Wastes!
